## OPEN AIR BURNING BY-LAW 2023-20

NO DAYTIME BURNING 8 am - 6 pm FROM APRIL 1 TO OCTOBER 31

To determine if a fire is permitted on your property please see the map on page 2.

## RECREATIONAL FIRE

A small fire permitted in the Urban Centre of Gravenhurst

## DO NOT BURN

- Larger than 61 cm by 61 cm ( 2 ft by 2 ft )
- In a manner that would adversely affect neighbouring properties and individuals
- Materials other than commercially produced charcoal, briquettes, or clean dry seasoned wood
- Within $6 \mathrm{~m}(20 \mathrm{ft})$ of an adjacent property or combustible structure or object
- Unless all of the general restrictions are met


## NON- RECREATIONAL FIRE

A fire larger than a recreational fire that is only permitted outside of the Urban Centre of Gravenhurst.

## DO NOT BURN

- Larger than 2 m by 2 m (6.5ft by 6.5 ft )
- Materials other than clean dry seasoned wood or yard waste
- Within $20 \mathrm{~m}(65 \mathrm{ft})$ of an adjacent building or structure or combustible object
- Without ensuring adjacent properties and individuals are protected from fire hazard and the effects of the products of combustion
- Unless all of the general restrictions are met


## GENERAL RESTRICTIONS FOR ALL FIRES

## DO NOT BURN

- From April 1st to October 31st from 8 am to 6 pm
- During a declared fire ban

NEW: Fireworks prohibited during a Town-declared Fire Ban

- Without having an effective extinguishing agent or device immediately available
- Unless supervised at all times
- Without ensuring the fire is completely extinguished before vacating
- When the wind speed exceeds $30 \mathrm{~km} /$ hour
- When a smog alert is in place
- NOTE: Sky lanterns are not permitted at any time


## WHAT KIND OF FIRE CAN I HAVE ON MY PROPERTY?

Properties within the purple area - A RECREATIONAL FIRE may be permitted Properties outside of the purple area - A NON-RECREATIONAL FIRE may be permitted
