<u>ANALYSIS</u>

The net budget for the Town to the end of Q1 2023 is 21% expended (Q1 2022 - 18% expended) and overall operating departments are in line with quarterly spending. It is anticipated the Town will continue to track within budget to year-end.

The Town continues to see savings in staff costs. The primary reason is that the Town faces the same sector challenges in hiring staff to fill existing vacancies in a competitive job market, despite repeated postings. While there is some financial gain with this challenge, there is inevitably impacts to service levels that Administration will be sure to notify Committee about as they arise.

Administration is also monitoring closely inflationary pressure points in comparison to the calculations used to compose the 2023 budget. As has been the practice, departments will make internal adjustments in-year as required and the Senior Leadership Team (SLT) will ensure that we come within budget at year end.
